


Environmental Policy

Enscope Consulting Ltd provides environmental consultancy services to the private and public sectors. The company is committed to providing high quality services which minimise potential impacts on the environment. The company will operate in compliance with all relevant environmental legislation and will strive to use best practice approaches across its services.

Enscope Consulting Ltd undertakes to manage its operations in accordance with the following:

- Client services – ensure that the company is adopting good practice approaches in all of its services, and best practice whenever feasible.
- Awareness – strive to adopt the lowest carbon footprint approaches to delivering services where possible.
- Electricity use – where electricity is not provided through independent, local renewable sources, the company will procure electricity from a green tariff supplier.
- Heating – the company will use biomass heating systems for work space heating whenever possible, with a high efficiency boiler system as back up. Green tariff suppliers will be used for the boiler system where services can be procured in a cost effective way.
- Energy efficiency – the company will ensure that insulation and draught exclusion measures to minimise heating requirements are adopted, with energy efficient lighting used where possible.
- Travel – All travel arrangements will be made with the aim of using public, scheduled transport services, instead of car transportation where this is reasonable. Where time, costs and logistics require air travel, carbon offsets will be purchased.
- Waste management – The main waste output from the company will be paper. All wastes of this type will either be composted locally or segregated and included within appropriate segregated paper collection services. All other recyclable wastes will be segregated for collection through appropriate local recycling services.
- Waste reduction – Reducing paper use is important and this will be achieved by printing documents double-sided or avoiding the printing of documents unless absolutely necessary.
- Procurement – Suppliers will be asked to provide products from the most sustainable sources possible. Where these are virtually cost neutral or lower cost, all supplies will be procured from such sources. Recycled paper will be purchased regardless of costs.
- Purchases of any new equipment will take into account the energy rating.
- Clients – Enscope Consulting will strive to influence clients and partnering organisations, by encouraging the adoption of more environmentally sustainable practices where possible.
